Build-A-Boat Contest Rules

1. Each team will consist of two people only. Moral support crews are however encouraged. Both team members must sign registration form. Children under 12 require parent's or guardian's signature.
2. Each team will be provided with an official Windjammer Weekend Build-A-Boat kit. Each kit contains two 4'x8' sheets of 1/4" plywood, four 2"x2"x10's, one pound of galvanized 3d nails, and 4 tubes of construction glue. (Please give the glue time enough to dry!)
3. Boats may be painted.
4. Boats must be built with materials provided, except paint, which is optional. **NO SUBSTITUTIONS OR ADDITIONS ALLOWED.**
5. Boats may be designed for oar or paddle. No sail(s).
6. Materials can be picked up anytime after 10am on Sat. Aug. 30 at the HarborMaster Shack in Camden, ME. Teams must return by 2:00pm Sunday, August 31st, for judging and a sea trial (short course around the fishermen's dock). Teams must have both people on board to compete. Both members of the team must wear USCG approved life jackets. Costumes optional but encouraged.
7. A panel of three judges will determine winners of the competition. The competition will have two parts—boat building skills and boat race. The boat building skills portion will include creativity and aesthetics. We are looking for originality and whimsy. Each boat must have a name. The boat race will be judged on seamanship and speed. Not only must your boat float, you must get it across the finish line.
